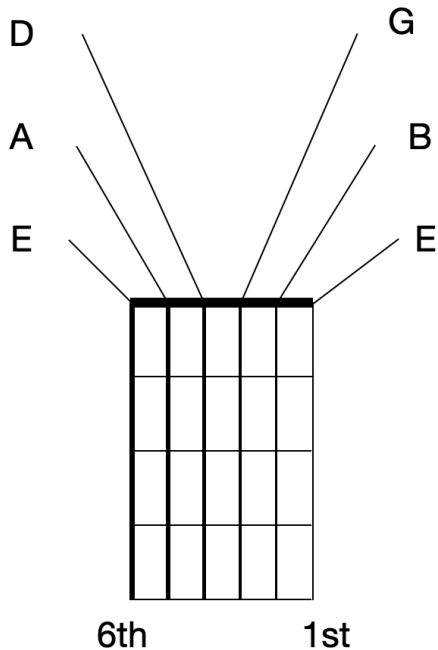

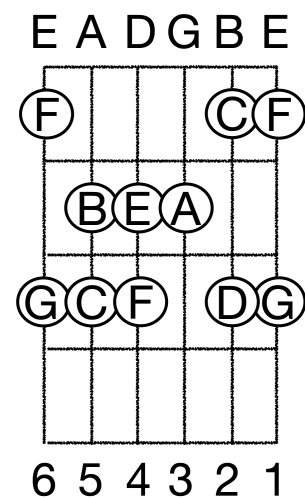

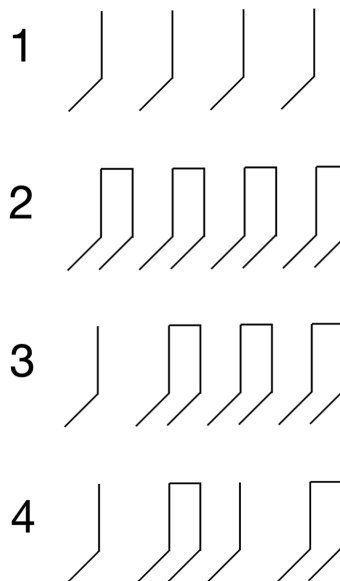
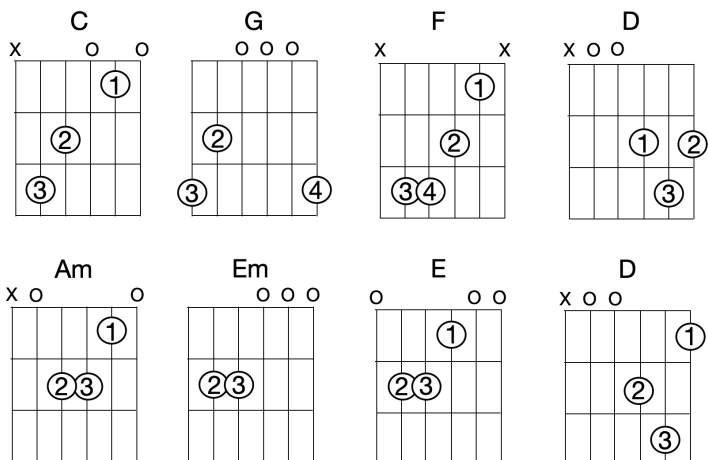
Standard Notation:
